


SHRUB PULLER

No Assembly Tools Required


Step 1: No Tools, One-Time Assembly

The only assembly is to insert the pivot frame between the parallel ends of the base frame as shown in Figure 2. Insert the 3/4" pivot pin through the parts and secure with the removable lynch pin.

Step 2: Cable Routing

Next, route the cable under this pivot pin, then upward and over the fixed pin near the top of the pivot frame. Install the second 3/4" pin and lynch pin to capture the loop end of the extraction cable between the fixed pin and 3/4" pin as shown in Figures 3 and 4.

Note: Moist soil is desirable when extracting shrubs to minimize the effort required. If necessary, thoroughly soak the root system before removal.



WARNING

- Always use another cable or log chain to pull the extraction cable loop.
- Never use a rope or sling because these will stretch and cause damage if the load limit is exceeded causing it to break.
- Never extract any shrub larger than 6" in diameter or tall enough to fall on you or any bystanders during extraction.
- · Never stand in the vicinity of the shrub as it's being pulled
- Never exceed the cable load limit of 2000 lbs. pulling force.
- Never pull straight away from the plant being extracted. Pull at a sideways angle as shown
